\$139,336*

This funding will be used to

- Build teacher capacity through professional development and implementation of Australian Curriculum to deliver differentiated programs to meet the individual needs of students.
- Continue teaching and learning conversations to support the school's improvement agenda in writing, reading and numeracy.
- Develop and implement individualised plans to support students who are below the national minimum standard.
- Increase/maintain the percentage of Year 3 students in the U2B:

Reading	Spelling	Writing	Numeracy
65%	55%	60%	60%

- Attain 93% of students achieving a C or above in English and Maths in year P to 6.
- Identify at risk students in literacy and numeracy and provide support.

Our initiatives include

- Continue implementation of Whole School Reading Program
- Engage teachers in analysis and discussion of school, classroom and individual student data to ensure learning pathways are suited to individual needs.
- Provide opportunities for coaching/mentoring to enhance collegial sharing and reflection of best practice.
- Providing literacy and numeracy support to identified students.
- Additional Speech Language Pathology time to support teachers, and students with speech language needs

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Allocating additional teacher aide time in P-6 classes to support whole school reading program, literacy and numeracy support.	\$40 000
• Purchasing additional teacher aide time to promote inclusive practices and cater to the diverse needs of students.	\$30 000
• Engage a P-2 inclusion teacher to support targeted students and build capability of teachers	\$25 000
• Engage a consultant to coach/mentor leadership team and teachers, to enhance collective efficacy and promote reflective practices.	\$5 000
• Release teachers to engage in data literacy and moderation of learning tasks	\$13 000
• Engage a School Support Officer (A04 1 day a week) to support school closing the gap strategy	\$16 000
• Purchasing additional speech pathology.	\$10 000
• Purchase of resources to support I4S strategies	\$ 336
