Student Dress Code

Seven Hills State School is a strict uniform school. We have the support of our Parents and Citizens Association to promote 100% adherence to the uniform. Our student dress code consists of an agreed standard and items of clothing, which included a school uniform that Seven Hills State School students wear when:

- attending or representing their school;
- travelling to and from school; and
- engaging in school activities out of school hours.

The Seven Hills State School Parents and Citizens' Association supports a student dress code policy because it believes that a student dress code provides clothing that aims to contribute to a safe and supportive teaching and learning environment through:

- ready identification of students and non-students at school;
- fostering a sense of belonging; and
- developing mutual respect among students by minimising visible evidence of economic or social differences.
- Promoting an effective teaching and learning environment by eliminating the distraction of competition in dress and fashion at the school

The Seven Hills State School student dress code reflects school community standards and is consistent with occupational health and safety and anti-discrimination legislation.

We will actively encourage our students to take pride in themselves and their school. One way in which this may be achieved is through adherence to the school's dress standards. As the parent/carer and provider of your child, we seek your support in this matter.

Inappropriate dress refers to clothing or apparel worn by students that is deemed to be:

- offensive;
- likely to disrupt, or negatively influence normal school operations;
- unsafe for students or others; and
- likely to result in a risk to health and safety of student or others.

Shoes and socks	 Socks: White or green Shoes: Black leather shoes, black joggers or white joggers. 	Students wearing inappropriate shoes will be asked to wear the school standard and may be excluded from outdoor activities.
Backpack	Green bag with school emblem	
Hat	 Green broad brimmed hat with school emblem (Years 1-6) Yellow legionnaires (Prep only) 	Students who do not have a hat for PE will be required to sit out of this activity. Students who do not have a sunsafe hat will be excluded from outdoor activities during play breaks. Students who do not have a hat will be ineligible to represent the school away from the campus.
Swimming	Students are to wear one piece swimming costumes only (two pieces swimmers are not permitted) Bathing Cap – Compulsory	Students wearing inappropriate swimming costumes will be ineligible to participate in swimming. Students not wearing swimming caps will be ineligible to participate in swimming.
Jewellery	The following items are acceptable additions to the school uniform: earrings (sleepers or studs only), watch, religious insignia, medical alert	A student wearing other jewellery will be asked to remove the item and if necessary give it to the teacher or take it to the office for safe- keeping for the remainder of the day.
Nail polish	Only clear nail polish may be worn.	Students wearing coloured nail polish will be asked to remove it by the following day.
